About the College

It established the Kannada and English Medium Schools in 1967 with a view to providing primary and secondary Education in Kannada and English Medium. Keeping in mind the maxim 'Think global and act local', the Sangha contributed to the growth of Higher Education by starting a Degree College named after the Lord - Marjunatha College of Commerce in 1999.
