About the College

Karnataka Sangha, one of the literary and cultural organizations, was established in 1967 by a group of enlightened citizens in and around Dombivli. It established the Kannada and English Medium Schools in 1967 with a view to providing primary and secondary Education in Kannada and English Medium. Keeping in mind the maxim **"Think global and act local"** the Sangha contributed to the growth of Higher Education by starting a Degree College named after the Lord - Manjunatha College of Commerce - in 1999.

The Government of Maharashtra and the University of Mumbai granted permission to Karnataka Sangha to establish and start "Manjunatha College of Commerce" - from the academic year 1999-2000.

The Sangha also bridged the gap between Secondary School Education and Higher Education by starting Karnataka Sangha's Junior College in 2006 - 2007 followed by Professional Courses like BMS from 2010 - 2011, BAF from 2014 - 2015 and BBI from 2016 - 2017. With a view to providing Education from KG to PG and increasing the ambit of Career options and opportunities to the young minds, the Sangha started M. Com. with Advanced Accountancy from 2013 - 2014. It received permission to start Ph. D. in Business Economics from 2017 - 2018.

The College is situated at Kanchangaon, Khambalpada, Thakurli (E) and is at a walking distance from Thakurli Station.

Objectives of the College

- To actively engage in discussions centred around Globalization and De-Globalization.
- To deliberate on the issues and challenges which emerge as one looks back as well as looks ahead of the contrary trends of Globalization and De-Globalization.

Concept Note

Although Globalization is a complex concept encompassing socio-cultural, politico-economic and religious aspects, one mainly refers to its economic aspect i. e. the integration of national and international economics through movement of capital, labour and technology (knowledge) across borders. The concept resonates with the ancient Indian concept encapsulated in the Sanskrit Phrase *Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam* (the world is one family). The 2030 Agenda lays emphasis on the need for global partnership (interdependence and multilateral co-operation) for sustainable development, however, one cannot be oblivious to the current trend of De-Globalization.

De-Globalization highlights a paradigm shift wherein several countries have shown their eagerness to adopt policies promoting their own national interests. Such policies often take the form of tariff and barriers which prevent free movement across borders and capital control (protecting local manufacturers and making imports costlier), evident in the instance of Brexit.

This interdisciplinary conference will provide an interactive platform for innovative ideas through a research oriented approach for academicians, corporates and researchers who will deliberate on Globalization and De-Globalization : Looking back and looking ahead.

No TA / DA will be provided to the participants.


**Report on One Day Multidisciplinary National Conference on one day Interdisciplinary National
