- 3) Scholarships and financial aid: Offer scholarships and financial aid to students from underrepresented religious backgrounds to encourage diversity.

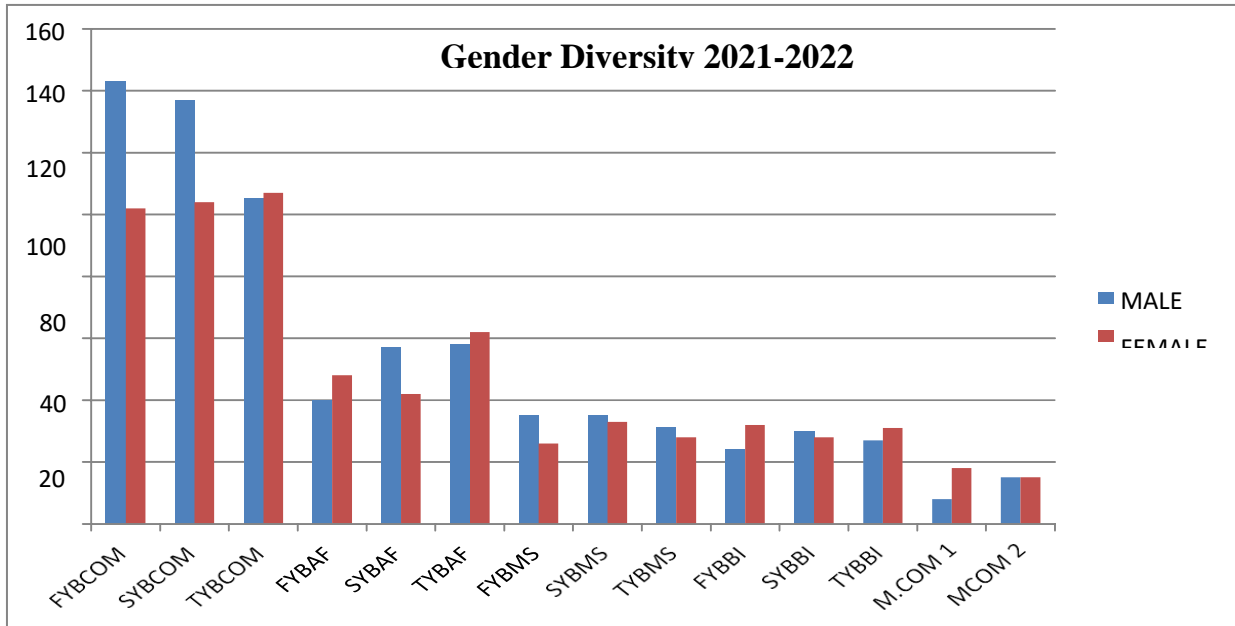
By taking these steps, the college can foster an inclusive atmosphere that values diversity and promotes the holistic development of all its students, regardless of their religious affiliations.



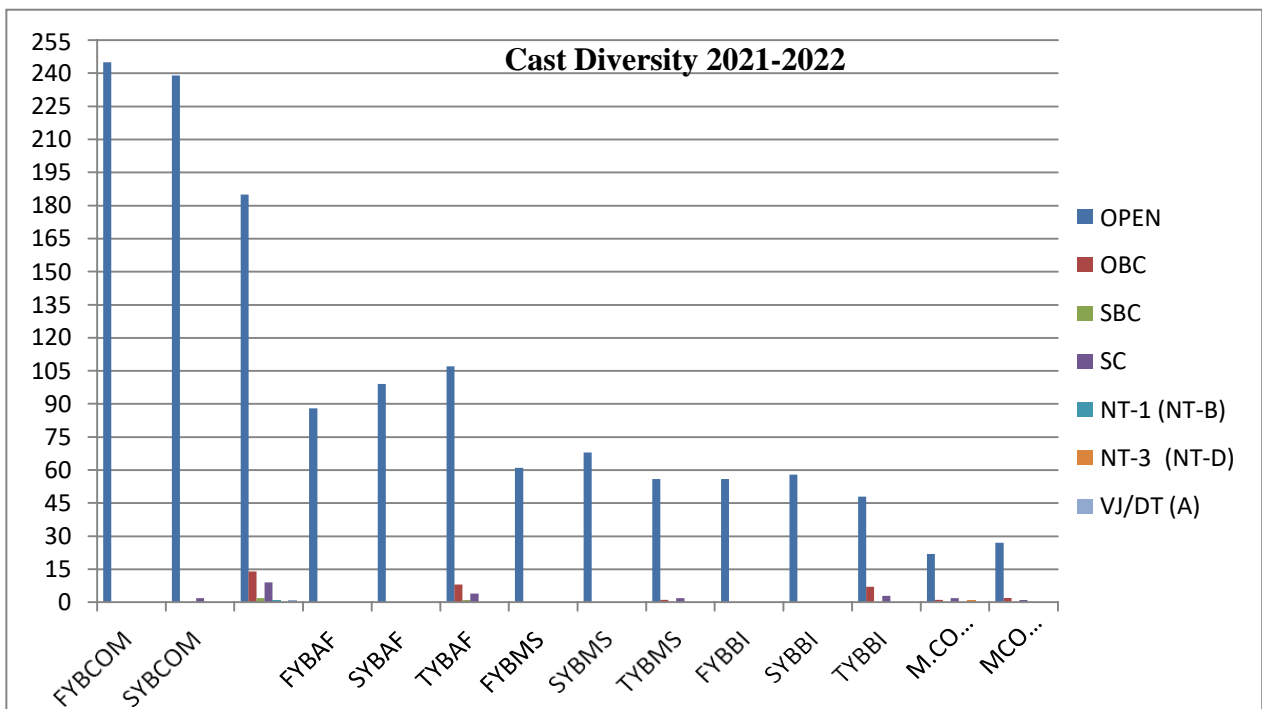
