



  4. Individual entry is allowed.
  5. Duration – 45 minutes
  6. In-charge faculty – Priyanka Madam
- **Handwriting Competition – 14/02/2023 – Tuesday at 11:00 am**
1. Competition Language – Marathi
  2. Marathi paragraph will be dictated
  3. Students should bring their own pen
  4. Use of only 1 colour pen is allowed
  5. In-charge faculty – Yogini Madam
- **Musical Chair Game – 15/02/2023 – Wednesday at 11:00 am**
1. Open to all
  2. Entry fees – Rs 20/-

## Report on Marathi Language Fortnight

### Inauguration Ceremony :-

### 13/02/2023 (Rangoli Competition) :-

Rangoli is considered a symbol of purity, beauty, auspiciousness, joy and enthusiasm. For this reason Marathi language fortnight was started with Rangoli competition. The type of 'Dot Rangoli' was seen in this competition. Craftsmanship, delicacy and variety of colors stood out from the competition. 20 students participated in this competition.

### 14/02/2023 (Signature Competition) :-

The challenge for the students was to prepare Maharashtrian food at home and sell it in the college. It was a delicious feast for the gourmants.
