7.1.1- Measures initiated by the Institution for the promotion of gender equity during the year.

Specific facilities provided for women in terms of:

- a. Safety and security-
- 1. <u>Provision Security Staff</u>:
 - College Campus has 24 Hours Security managed by 'Force Security Services'.
 - Female Security staff and female peons appointed for overall security of girls. Dedicated lady peon for the girl's room.
 - Security guards for checking the entry and exit of the students.
 - Male security guards working in three shifts for the security of entire College premises.
 - Women's Development Cell, Anti-sexual harassment and Anti-Ragging cell, and Discipline committee are for the security of students (for both Male & Female).

2. <u>CCTV Surveillance</u>:

 The campus has 54 CCTV in Classrooms, Staff room, Corridors, Library, College office, Principal's cabin, Examination room, Auditorium, Gymkhana, Canteen and at various locations in the College premises, which are monitored from Principal's cabin and trustees room & also in mobiles of Chairman, Karnataka sangha and Principal of college.

3. <u>Students' Welfare</u>:

- Academic Advisors (Class Teachers) are appointed for solving doubts and counselling the students. Class Representatives and Lady Representatives are appointed to help identifying the problems of girl students which can be resolved on a regular basis.
- Committees like Commerce Association, Accountancy Association,

Economics Colloquium, and Management Association along with Student's Council and Cultural Committee, Marathi Vangmay Mandal etc are actively working for hunting the talent of male and female students for their overall growth.

- 3 Sanitary pad vending machines and incineration machines are installed and there is a provision of sanitary pads on payment.
- Girl topper students are awarded special cash prizes and trophies.

b. Counselling –

Career counselling and personal counselling is regularly done by academic advisors and teachers besides organizing guest lectures and programs.

Discussions on gender equity is done during lectures. Guest lecture on family relations, essay writing on well-known women who helped to build our nation, Gender training and gender fair helped in counselling the learners. In Foundation Course, discussions on gender ratio, women's roles in politics and media etc. created Self-motivation among the learners.

c. Common Rooms –

Girls' Common Room is near the first floor washroom. It is equipped with sanitary napkin vending machine with incineration machine.

Female and male staff are appointed for monitoring washrooms and maintain the discipline.



f. Vacha may provide a platform to Karnataka Sangha's Manjunatha College of Commerce & Jr. College of Commerce students to participate and contribute in various extension and social welfare initiatives taken by them as part of their CSR activities.

g. Vacha may provide internship opportunity to Karnataka Sangha's Manjunatha College of Commerce & Jr. College of Commerce students whenever such an opportunity arises.

h. Vacha may provide research opportunity to Karnataka Sangha's Manjunatha College of Commerce & Jr. College of Commerce students by involving then in various research projects undertaken by Vacha, whenever such an opportunity arises.

5. Commercials:

This collaboration is free of cost. Vacha shall not charge any fees on whatsoever account/name from the students or the College for conducting the aforesaid extension program.
