
A. Feedback on Teaching Learning Process

Report of Students' Satisfaction Survey

The Students' Satisfaction Survey was conducted by using Google form and following is a brief report on the findings and actions taken:

A) Findings:

Teaching- Learning:

- ✓ Nearly 64% students agreed that more than 85% syllabus was covered in the class.
- ✓ More than 80% students appreciated the student-centric teaching approach.
- ✓ Nearly 85% students were satisfied with multiple learning and growth avenues.
- ✓ Nearly 95% students confirmed that the lectures were conducted regularly.
- ✓ Nearly 66% students confirmed that more than 70% teachers used ICT tools in the classroom.
- ✓ Majority of them were satisfied with the fairness of internal evaluation by teachers.
- ✓ Majority of the students accepted that the teachers identify their strengths and motivate them to utilise their strengths and also identify their weaknesses and help them to overcome their weaknesses.
- ✓ Nearly 66% students expressed that they aware of POs and COs and 72% felt that the teaching-learning process helped them to achieve POs and COs.

Institution:

Nearly 90% to 95 % students gave positive feedback with regards to access to Principal and interaction with the teachers, support from Admin office.

There was positive feedback on various facilities like Library, computer lab, Classroom ambience, safe drinking water, canteen, sanitation and campus cleanliness.

Nearly 85% students gave positive feedback on conduct of Sports and Extracurricular activities.

98% of the students agreed that the college conducts Add-on/ Value added courses as well as awareness about the provision of Scholarships/ Freeships/ Financial Aid.

In a nutshell, the survey reinforced the quality of teaching-learning process and the overall impression about the college.

B) Actions Taken:

Discussed in the staff meeting and suggestions for improvement were noted down as below:

- ✓ More teachers should be encouraged to use ICT tools in their teaching-learning process.
- ✓ More students should be made aware of POs and COs through repeated discussions in the class.
- ✓ Alongwith Add-on courses, the students should be encouraged to participate in the online courses offered by MOOCs/ SWAYAM.
- ✓ Inculcate research culture not only among staff but also students.
- ✓ Interact with the parents through whatsapp groups and keep them updated about the progress of their wards.
